



You may recall that I have been chasing you for filling up of vacancies in this office, especially after 12 (twelve) posts were transferred from Railway Claims Tribunal, Kolkata Bench and new bench came into operation. The PCPO's office advertised the posts for these vacancies, but unfortunately only five numbers of applications have been received. Out of this also, on scrutiny, only two applications of one Sr. Clerk and one Peon have been found suitable and PCPO's office has been informed for issue of their orders. Rest of candidate have not been found fit, considering the fact that this office works with very limited number of staff and it is important to have a sincere and hardworking person to be posted.

This office was in absolute need of a Court Master and as a result of notifying this post in Grade Pay 4200/-, only three optees have come out since staff who were already in GP 4600/- were not allowed to apply. This office has three vacant posts of Private Secretary in Grade Pay 4600/- and with the present situation, it is unlikely to get these posts filled up. I have given my approval for two out of three posts to be upgraded - one post for Court Master and one post for Office Superintendent (Registry) in Grade Pay 4600/-. You are now requested to advise PCPO to issue fresh notification. As the posting of staff is already delayed and the second Bench is already in operation, a short notice of two weeks may be given for seeking the applications against the post of Court Master/Chief OS in Grade Pay 4600/-. This may be treated as very urgent for an early notification.

N. F. Railway has been pro-actively helping this Tribunal and this effort on the part of N. F. Railway will help this office to streamline the working in a much better way.

You are requested to do needful in the matter.

Sub: Filling up of all Group 'C' & 'D' vacancies in various Benches.

The functioning of Railway Claims Tribunal is quasi judicial and providing man power is obligatory on the Central Government (Section 12 of RCT Act). Keeping posts vacant for uncertain period would of course hamper its working and as a result of which the compensation to death/injured railway victims & other cases would be delayed adding to their agony and pain. Undue delay in adjudicating the claims pending before the Tribunals very often arrests attention of paper and electronic media which needs to be avoided.

Railway Board vide its letter No.2000/TC(RCT)/8-1, dated 01.10.07 (Copy enclosed), in supersession of all previous instructions, has decided that "All Group 'C' & 'D' posts in the RCTs, except as indicated in Part 2 below, will be filled by serving Railway employees in appropriate analogous grade or one grade below with a minimum of two years regular service in that grade, on transfer basis on a tenure of 5 years or till he/she is due for promotion in his/her parent cadre, whichever is later.....". The vacancy position of RCT Benches spreading all over India is enclosed, to have an idea of the number of vacancies, places where there are vacancies and the posts which are yet to be manned. This may be widely circulated to all Railway Offices. Once the staff is not available or willing to be posted in RCT in analogous grade, the offer should be advanced to all those who are one grade below with two years regular service. This mode will not only be monetarily beneficial to the staff but also, it will enable the staff to get themselves posted at or near to their own home town. Names of all such willing staff should be sent to the Principal Bench for consideration and their selection.

Another aspect is the filling up of the posts of Asstt Registrars or Adml. Registrars, which is also of much importance. It has been seen that in some Benches the AR/DR is from Accounts Cadre while the Accounts Officer in

RCT is always from the Accounts side, thereby leaving every chance to go things unchecked or counter checked. It has, therefore, been decided by the Hon'ble Chairman that henceforth ARs/ADRs should always be selected from other than accounts Cadre so that proper counter check could take place. Moreover, for the post of Addl Registrar which is a J.A Grade post, Railway Board had decided that ~~it~~ being considered this post should be a Law Graduate stipulating other conditions, a copy of which is also enclosed for your kind information. Names of the willing Officers for posting in any of the Benches may be sent to the Principal Bench of the RCT for kind consideration and selection by the Hon'ble Chairman.

It is requested that while circulating these vacancies, a time schedule may be fixed so that sincere efforts to fill up at least all Group 'C' & 'D' are translated into positive results.

An early action in this regard shall be highly appreciated.
