Notice to Non-PwBD candidates regarding re-medical examination against Notification No.CEN-02/2018 **Dated 26-05-2022**

In response to RRC NFR Notice dated 27-12-2021, out of 117 candidates CEN 02/2018, who were not empanelled due to being found unfit in relevant medical category, 43 candidates had applied for re-medical examination within one month's time as per rules and guidelines of Railways. Re-medical examination of 02 candidates has already been done.

Now, Competent Authority of Medical Department/NFR has approved for re-medical examination of following 20 candidates at Central Hospital/Maligaon/Guwahati.

5	NISCHAL KUMAR	202072106370013	B-2	B-1	The candidate has defective colour vision, as such, for his appeal for re-medical examination, he needed to submit medical certificate from Ophthalmologist (Eye specialist). The certificate produced is by Dr. N. Sinha, who is not an ophthalmologist. As such the appeal is rejected.
6	VIKAS KIMAR	202076082120005	B-2	B-2	The candidate has submitted medical certificate by Dr. Uday Shankar Prasad mentioning that he is fit in Bee Two (B2) which is same category as mentioned in IME done at KIR Divisional Railway Hospital. As such, there is no reason for his re-medical examination.

7	SUJAL BISWAS	202081081160006	B-2	B-2	The opinion of the specialist doctor's certificate produced by the candidate is same as of IME report. As such, there is no need for the re-medical examination. Hence, the appeal for re-medical examination is rejected."

10	BHEEM SINGH YADAV	202093079550018	B-2 & below	A-2	The medical certificate produced by the candidate does not provide the medical qualification of the Doctor. The MCI registration is also incorrect. In view of the above, the appeal for re-medical examination is rejected.
11	AMRESH KUMAR	202096095170005	C-2	B-1	The candidate has been declared UNFIT due to substandard vision, as such, the medical certificate should be from an ophthalmologist. The certificate produced is by Dr. P.D.Sharma who is an orthopedician and is not competent to comment on vision. As such, the appeal for re-medical examination is rejected."
12	JITENDRA KUMAR	202099042730063	B-2	B-1	The medical qualification of Dr. A.K.Pandey is not mentioned. The candidate needs to produce medical certificate from Ophthalmologist (Eye specialist). As such, the appeal for re-medical examination is rejected.
13	SUMIT RAJ	202108034930042	B-2 with glass	B-1	On the medical certificate produced by the candidate, given by Dr. Kisto Kumar (Reg.no. 22142), no qualification of the doctor is available. Also on verification, the Reg. No. 22142 does not belong to Dr. Kisto Kumar. Hence the appeal is rejected.
14	SANU ROY	202111081160278	B-2 & below	B-2	The candidate has produced medical certificate from Dr. D.Das, mentioning that he is Fit in Bee

					Two (B2) which is same as IME fit certificate which states that he is fit in Bee Two (B2) and below. As such there is no reason for re-medical examination.
15	RAJPAL KUMAR	202116082130013	B-2	B-2	The certificate produced by the candidate also certified him FIT in Bee Two (B2) category which is same as of IME report. As such, there is no need for re-medical examination. Hence, the appeal for re-medical examination is rejected.

18	RAJAT DAS	202139081160281	C-1 & below with glass	B-1	The candidate should produce certificate by on Ophthalmologist as he has been declared unfit in Aye-Two (A2) but fit in Cee-One (C1) due to defective vision. As such the appeal for re-medical examination of Sri Rajat Das cannot be considered.
19	DIPAK DAS	202150079300042	B-2 & below	A-1	The candidate has been detected colour vision defective, as such he should produce certificate from concerned specialist i.e. ophthalmologist for his Appeal for re-medical examination. The certificate produced is by a MBBS doctor, not by specialist, as such the appeal for re-medical examination of Sri Dipak Das , cannot be considered.
20	NIPPON MALLICK	202047031770006	C-1 & below with glass	B-1	The medical certificate produced by Dr. Suprakash Roy, MS(Ophthalmology) WBMC-56315, it is mentioned that visual acuity is BE:6/12, N-6 with -4.00D SPH, CV(N) as such he is not fit in Bee-one(B1)/BeeTwo(B2) but fit in Cey-one (C1) and below medical category. As such his appeal cannot be considered.

21	VISHAL KUMAR	202106083200146	B-2 & below	A-2	On the medical certificate produced by the candidate from Dr. P.M.Sahay (Reg.no. 22139), no qualification of the doctor is available. Also on verification, the Reg. No. 22139 does not belong to Dr. P.M.Sahay. Hence, the appeal is rejected."
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
