**Sub:- System Improvement to discontinue Consolidated Travelling Allowance (CTA) to ticket checking staff working in squad**

During preventive check regarding remittance of earning and submission of EFT return by ticket checking staff, it was found that Ticket checking staff (Except CTI & TE) are getting **Consolidated travelling allowance (CTA) in N. F.Rly, which is equal to 100% travelling allowance for 20 days.** But on examination of duty roster it was found that TTEs of Squad do not stay outside HQ and return to HQ on every day and perform duty less than or equal to 08(eight) hrs. If they claim TA for 26 days (Considering 4 days rest in a month) even then @ 70% they are eligible for 26 days X 0.7(@70%)= 18.2 days full TA instead of 20 days CTA. To save this undue excess allowance, following system improvement is suggested:-

**Consolidated Travelling Allowance (CTA) to checking staff working in squad may be discontinued and travelling allowance on actual basis be implemented.**
