

Sub: - Suggestion for implementation of System Improvement over Indian Railways.

During various preventive checks by Zonal Vigilance/NFR in trains, It has been observed that there is no rule which empowers the ticket checking authority to ask proof of age of the child from the guardian/parents as needed to carry during train journey. It provides the opportunity to the guardian/parents to misdeclare the age of child for which the ticket checking authorities are unable to regularise such child in Train. It should be made mandatory to carry proof of age for the child/children whose names are not in the PNR.

Hence, it is requested to examine the feasibility for implementation of the System Improvement in this regard over Indian Railways and arrange policy guideline issued from the Railway Board.
