Sub: Selection of Chief Vigilance Inspector/Vigilance Inspector/Mechanical in pay matrix Level-7 (equivalent to PB-II (Pay band of ₹ 9300-34800/- + GP ₹4600/-) for N. F. Railway Vigilance Department.

1. It has been decided to hold selection for 01 (one) post of **Chief Vigilance Inspector/Mechanical in pay matrix Level-7 (equivalent to PB-II (Pay band of ₹ 9300-34800 + GP ₹4600/-)** in order to fill up Ex-cadre posts of Chief Vigilance Inspector/Mechanical in the Vigilance Department of N. F. Railway on deputation basis.
2. Applications/Options are hereby invited from the **staff working in technical cadre of Mechanical Department having knowledge of Mechanical Engineering** in the **prescribed pro-forma attached herewith**, which should be **duly forwarded by the Controlling Officer** for filling up of above posts on deputation. Deputation period will be for three years (subject to vide GM(P)/MLG/NFR's L/No. NFR-HQ0VIGL(MISC)/1/2023 dated 03/02/2023), which may be extended for further two years only on the basis of performance and requirement. However, the staff selected for the post could be repatriated at any time, on or before completion of the tenure without assigning any reason whatsoever.
3. Wide publicity amongst the staff working as **SSE/JE, Mechanical Inspector or Equivalent post** in the Mechanical department in pay matrix of Level-7 (Pay band of 9300- 34800/- + GP ₹4600 in 6th CPC) or one scale below i. e. JE in Mechanical department in Level-6 (Pay band of 9300- 34800/- + ₹4200 of 6th CPC) on regular basis) may kindly be given.
4. Applications of the willing staff, who fulfil the prescribed eligibility criteria and other terms and conditions as mentioned here in under, should be **forwarded by the respective Controlling officer along with APARs** of the staff of last 3 years (2019-2020, 2020-21 & 2021-22) **to reach this office by 25.05.2023.**

5. Eligibility Criteria

- (i) Staff working as SSE in the Mechanical department in pay matrix of Level-7 (Pay band of 9300- 34800/- + GP ₹4600 in 6th CPC) or one scale below i. e. JE in Mechanical department in Level-6 (Pay band of 9300- 34800/- + ₹4200 of 6th CPC) on regular basis. **Ministerial staff of Mechanical department are not eligible.**
- (ii) The staff should have completed at least five years of service in Railways as on the date of notification (i. e. on **25-5-2023**).
- (iii) The staff should have minimum 08 (eight) years of service left (i. e. on **25-5-2023**)
- (iv) Staff should have sound integrity, should not be figuring in any current Vigilance/SPE/DAR case and should not have been imposed any major/minor penalty in any past vigilance case.
- (v) Staff who has already completed his tenure in Vigilance Organization of Zonal Railways/Production Units/Railway Board as Investigating Inspector (Vigilance) /Vigilance Inspector are not eligible.

6. Selection Procedure:

- (i) A Written Test, Vigilance Aptitude and Computer Knowledge Test will be conducted as part of selection procedure. The distribution of marks for selection is stated below:

- (ii) The candidates who obtain at least 60% marks in the written test has to appear for Vigilance Aptitude & Computer knowledge test.
- (iii) The written test will include questions on knowledge about Railway working, writing of report, knowledge about the Railway Service (Conduct) Rules, Discipline & Appeal Rules, knowledge of rules, Regulations, Codes, manuals, circulars, regular working/functioning of Mechanical department and technical knowledge of Mechanical Engineering.
- (iv) For Chief Vigilance Inspector/Mechanical in pay matrix Level-7, Staff working as SSE (Works, P-Way, Bridge, Track Machine, Drawing & Design) in the Mechanical department in pay matrix of Level-7 (Pay band of 9300- 34800/- + GP ₹4600 in 6th CPC) or one scale below i. e. JE in Mechanical department in Level-6 (Pay band of 9300- 34800/- + ₹4200 of 6 PC) on regular basis will be considered.

7. Other terms and conditions:

- (i) The staff should have flair for vigilance work, capable of expressing themselves coherently, logically and be good in drafting report, Adequate knowledge of D&AR proceedings, manuals, codes, guidelines and computer proficiency is desirable.
- (ii) The normal establishment rules applicable to regular selection posts are not applicable in the selection of Vigilance department [as per para 821.5 of IRVM].
- (iii) Vigilance works involve excessive travelling, long and continuous journey and camp life. Therefore, the staff should have interest and physical fitness for the same.
- (iv) The posts of CVIs/Sr. VIs being Ex. Cadre Tenure posts, there is no provision of reservation of vacancies for employees of reserved category. However, the employees belonging to reserved category may be encouraged to apply.
- (v) Applicants, once selected, will not be allowed to withdraw their names.
- (vi) **It may be noted by controlling officer that it will be compulsory to release the employee after selection.**
- (v) Vigilance is an ex-cadre organization. Therefore, staff selected for posting in the vigilance department will continue to maintain their lien and seniority in their parent cadre.
- (vi) Selected staff will be posted on tenure basis. The normal period of tenure is 3 years, which could be extended as per extant rules/guidelines issued from time to time. However, performance of each Inspector would be reviewed a little before completing two years in the Vigilance department and thereafter further extension and tenure, if warranted, should be made on year-to-year basis with a similar review before every such extension is decided upon.

- (vii) The posting in the Vigilance Organization is on a purely temporary basis and that the Railway Administration has a right to repatriate the person at any time and without assigning any reason, even if he has not completed initial period of tenure or extension, if any, granted thereto.
- (viii) No staff will have or can claim a legal right to continue in a post in the Vigilance Organization either indefinitely or for a specific period.

8. Submission of application:

- (i) Application, as per enclosed pro-forma must be filled and signed by the candidate himself/herself, giving the correct information to the best of his/her knowledge. No alterations/corrections on the application will be entertained.
- (ii) Application should be made in the prescribed pro-forma, and should be forwarded through the proper channel (Controlling Officer). Applications not received through the proper channel will be summarily rejected. No direct applications will be entertained.
- (iii) No alteration/correction on the application will be entertained. Applicants must note that if any information furnished by him/her is found to be false at any stage, the application/candidature will be liable to be rejected. Submission of false or misleading information by applicant may lead to D&AR action.
- (iv) **The applications of willing eligible candidates should be forwarded along with certified copies of last 03 years (2019-20, 2020-21 & 2021-22) APARs & DAR clearance to this Office.**
- (v) The applications/options **duly forwarded through proper channel** (controlling Officer) should reach in the Office of the General Manager/Vigilance, Northeast Frontier Railway, Maligaon latest by **25-05-2023, along with attested photograph.**

Application of those employees who have not undergone any penalty in a vigilance case/SPE case during their service period, and of employees who have not undergone any penalty under DAR in the last 03 years, **should only be forwarded.**
